Most Eminent Highness,

Most Reverend Excellency, Excellencies, Members of the Chapter,

According to the new Constitutional Charter and Code, the Receiver of the Common Treasure has the duty to present to the General Chapter a report on the utilisation of the funds given by the different bodies and members of the Order.

In the performance of my duty, therefore, I present herewith attached the Budget for the Financial Contributions made by the Order's Members to the Grand Magistry. This Budget (annex A) has been prepared in collaboration with the Financial Commission, founded by the Presidents and approved by the Camera dei Conti. The document that is being delivered has been put on the Agenda (point 8) and will be discussed tomorrow.

Nevertheless, also the report on the general situation of the Order, both from the economic and financial points of view, obviously lies within the province of the Receiver of the Common Treasure. To perform this duty, I have prepared a document from which you will notice the economic and property increases that have been recorded in the last five years; summing up, from the economic point of view there has been an increase of L. 2,142 miliardi and from the property point of view there has been an increase of L. 12,302 milliards. Figures and trends are confirmed by the Camera dei Conti's report, which is also attached (annex B).

You will certainly have time to read it before the meeting of tomorrow. I thank you for your attention.
